How to find us

By Car

From the North on the M6

Leave the M6 at Junction 6 heading for the city centre on the Aston Expressway. Take the second exit (Middle Ring Road).

Follow the ring road across traffic lights, two roundabouts, under railway bridges then turn left at the next roundabout (signposted to Bordesley Green and Heartlands Hospital).

St. Paul's is approximately 1.5 miles out on this road, turning right at the roundabout where Belchers Lane crosses Bordesley Green (look for McDonalds).

From the East on M6 and Northeast on M42

Leave M6 at Junction 5, and follow the A47 to the junction with the outer ring road (A4040) at the 'Fox and Goose'.

Turn left and follow the ring road for 1.5 miles to the junction with Bordesley Green East at Stechford Police Station (traffic lights). Turn right, (signposted to Bordesley Green and Heartlands Hospital). Continue for approximately 1 mile turning left at the roundabout where Belchers Lane crosses Bordesley Green.

From South and West on the M42

Leave the M42 at Junction 6 and follow the A45 towards the City Centre until the junction with the outer ring road (A4040) at the 'Swan'.

Turn right and follow the ring road for 1 mile to the junction with Bordesley Green East at Stechford Police Station (traffic lights).

Turn left (signposted Bordesley Green and Heartlands Hospital).

Continue for approximately 1 mile turning left at the roundabout where Belchers Lane crosses Bordesley Green.

By Train

Arrive at Birmingham New Street Station, leave through the glass doors, not the escalators. (For local journeys, Moor Street Station is nearer the bus stops.)

A taxi journey from here will take approx. 20 minutes.

Alternatively, buses 97/97A will travel to Bordesley Green. To get to the bus stop, walk past the car park and bear left to Marks and Spencer. Walk past M&S and turn right into Carrs Lane and left at the end. The bus stops are in front of Carrs Lane church. Ask to be dropped at 'The Broadway' or McDonalds on Belchers Lane. This journey will take approx. 30 minutes.

By Bus

Routes 97/97A from Carrs Lane Church/Moor St Queensway in the City Centre. See 'By Train'. Route 28 between Small Heath/Heartlands Hospital and Great Barr uses Belchers Lane; again ask to be dropped at McDonalds. Buses 13, 17, 169 (from Solihull) and 663 also stop relatively close by.

St Paul's Centre

Is situated just 100 yards down Belchers Lane from the roundabout at McDonalds. Look for the green spire.
